

Procedure	Accepted
<b>Gastroscopy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Diagnostics</li> <li>• Barretts Surveillance</li> <li>• D2 biopsy</li> </ul>
<b>Colonoscopy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Diagnostics</li> <li>• Left side Polyps &lt;2.5cm</li> <li>• Right side Polyps &lt;=1.5cm</li> </ul>
<b>Flexible Sigmoidoscopy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Diagnostics</li> </ul>

## Exclusions:

- Requiring immediate referral to secondary care
- Requiring an urgent referral/2ww (*unless contracted*)
- Under 18 years of age (*unless contracted*)
- Medically unfit - ASA level 3 or above
- MI/heart attack in the last 3 months
- Unstable angina
- Severe COPD (Lower GI only)
- Pacemaker/ICD (Lower GI only)
- Severe heart failure
- Weight >220kg (34 stone)
- Dye spray for IBD surveillance
- Therapeutics: Banding of haemorrhoids, Variceal banding
- Unable to comply with good practice in consent
- Mobility issues - not ambulant
- Known history of violent, abusive or threatening behaviour (*recorded by GP Practice or other health professionals*)
- Being screened for a family history of colorectal cancer
- Referred from the Screening Programme
- Referred for Capsule Endoscopy

## Additional Information:

- **Mobility** – must be able to transfer from chair to trolley and turn 180° (left to right hand side on trolley)
- **Barrett's Surveillance** - long segment Barrett's (ie 3cm or more) is for secondary care surveillance unless contractually agreed
- **Large polyps** – these will be clinically assessed if safe for removal in a community site according to size, site and type of polyp. A size guide is listed above in the acceptance criteria
